SECTION I

ORGANIZATION OF THE DISTRICT SCHOOL SYSTEM

1.01 THE DISTRICT SCHOOL SYSTEM

- A. The District School System—Clay County District Schools ("District") shall include all public schools, classes and courses of instruction and all services and activities directly related to education in the dDistrict which are under the direction of the dDistrict school officials. The organizational structure for the district schools shall be: Elementary, grades PreK-6; Junior High, grades 7-8; High, grades 9-12; and Adult and Community Education.
- B. "The District School System shall be considered as a part of the state system of public education. All actions of dDistrict school officials shall be consistent and in harmony with state laws and rules, and regulations, and minimum standards of the State Board of Education. District school officials, however, shall have the authority to provide additional educational opportunities, as desired, which are authorized, but not necessarily required by law."
