

RESOLUTION 17-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THAT PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS BUILDING 95 ROOMS 4, 5 and 6 AT THE MAINTENANCE ANNEX, 6 SOUTH ROBERTS STREET, GREEN COVE SPRINGS, FLORIDA WERE TAKEN OUT OF SERVICE FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES BY CODE ENFORCEMENT AND HAVE SINCE BEEN USED AS STORAGE AND HAVE NO COMMERCIAL VALUE AND SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF BY THE MOST ECONOMIC MEANS.

WHEREAS, The School Board of Clay County, Florida wants to dispose of the structures described as relocatable Building 95, Rooms 4, 5 and 6 located at the Maintenance Annex; and

WHEREAS, the structures have deteriorated, are not cost effective to repair and are no longer utilized, serve no useful function and are without commercial value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 1013.28 requires a determination that said structures are unusable for educational purposes and ancillary purposes and have no commercial value;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the School Board to dispose of said property by the most economical means;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Clay County, Florida, that the following described property is unusable for education and ancillary purposes and is without commercial value and in the best interest of the public should be disposed of by the most economical means. Said property is more particularly described as follows:

Structures: Building 95 Room 4, CI #243, Room 5, CI #61 and Room 6, CI #33 are relocatable wooden buildings constructed in 1966 and 1941 currently at the Maintenance Annex, 6 South Roberts Street, Green Cove Springs, Florida.
