Following the convening of multiple groups representing a cross-section of school district staff and community partners, recommended edits were made to the 2018-19 Code of Student Conduct. Updates to vocabulary and/or statutory references were made throughout the document; those specific edits will not be summarized here.

NOTE: The words "offenses" and "violations" were often changed to "infractions" throughout the document to align with current practices.
