AMENDMENT NUMBER FIVE (5) TO CONTRACT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND ACHIEVE3000, INC.

This Amendment Number Five (5) to the Contract (hereafter "original Contract") between **THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA** ("Board"), and **ACHEIVE3000, INC.** ("Contractor"), collectively referred to as "the Parties," which original Contract was entered into by the parties on June 19, 2014, and was duly executed by Carol Studdard for the Board and Peter Saretsky for the Contractor, shall become effective on the date last executed by either of the parties and shall serve to modify original Contract as set forth herein.

WHEREAS, the 2014 Contract concerned the licensing and provisions of computer-based education programming, assessment, and associated services ("the Program") for a limited number of district students and employees, and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into Amendments Number One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) in 2017, 2018 and 2019 to expand the scope and duration of the 2014 Contract, and

WHEREAS, the term of the 2014 Contract, as previously amended, expires June 30, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the Parties to the Contract seek to extend the term of the original Contract for an additional three (3) years, with a new termination date of June 30, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the Parties now seek to update to Contractor's newest product to "Acheive3000 Pro Florida" with the services available under said product being utilized at forty-four (44) schools in the Clay County School District, and

WHEREAS, the total three-year cost of the new product will increase from One Million Four Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty-One Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$1,474,341.74) to One Million Nine Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Sixty Dollars and Sixty-Four Cents (\$1,924,060.64).

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties have mutually agreed to modify the terms of the original Contract as follows:

- 1. The 2014 Contract is hereby amended such that the term is extended to June 30, 2023.
- 2. Program shall be made available to employees and students at the forty-four (44) Clay County School District sites listed in Attachment "A," a copy of which is attached hereto.
- 3. The product provided to the Board by Contractor pursuant to this Amendment Five (5) shall be Acheive 3000 Pro Florida.
- 4. The total three-year cost of the product and attendant services provided for in this Amendment Five (5) and the Attachment A is One Million Nine Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Sixty Dollars and Sixty-Four Cents (\$1,924,060.64). The rates, costs and other terms of service shall be governed by Attachment A.
- 5. The modifications previously made in Amendments One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) are subsumed by the terms of this Amendment Five (5) and are therefore rendered moot.
- 6. All other terms and conditions of the original Contract shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect.
- 7. The only effect of this Amendment Five (5) is to modify the Contract as set forth herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties, by the execution of this Amendment Five (5) by their authorized representatives below, bind themselves to all terms of this Amendment Five (5) to the original Contract and to the remaining unmodified terms of the Original Contract and previous Amendments.



Notwithstanding any other provision of this agreement, if funds for the continued fulfillment of this agreement by Customer are at any time not forthcoming or insufficient through failure of any entity to appropriate funds or otherwise, Customer shall have the right to terminate this agreement in whole or in part without penalty (including without payment of the balance of the designated service term of 36 months) by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice documenting the lack of funding. The total or partial termination of this agreement shall become effective upon the last day of the fiscal period for which appropriations were received. Customer agrees that it will make its best efforts to obtain sufficient funds, including but not limited to including in its budget for each fiscal period during the term of the agreement a request for sufficient funds to meet its obligations hereunder in full. In the event of a total or partial termination of this agreement in accordance with this paragraph, Customer may not obtain similar service during the initial term of the agreement. In the event of such termination, Contractor shall be entitled to retain or recover from the District all fees paid or due to be paid for setup and staff development training that have been provided to the District, and the portion of the subscription fee that is applicable to the period that the Users were provided access to the educational service(s), and shall return to the District the portion of any paid subscription fee applicable to the period following the termination date that the Users were to be provided access to the educational service(s), if any.
