- Board members will score candidates and Ms. Troutman will keep a tally of scores to provide information on total scores to board members

 process
- The board may, at this meeting, make a motion to direct the superintendent and board chair to enter into employment contract negotiations with the candidate of choice
- Employment contract negotiations do not subscribe to an established timeline
- A mutually agreed upon/finalized contract will be submitted onto the agenda of a regular board meeting to be voted on/approved by the board.
