PROCLAMATION # 23-07

WHEREAS, Schools can more effectively ensure that all students are able to learn when they meet the needs of the whole child and provide integrated, multi tiered supports; and

WHEREAS, Positive educational and social outcomes for all children and youth are possible only in a society—and schools within it—that affirm and value the diversity of each child; and

WHEREAS, School psychologists take steps to foster a school climate that is supportive, safe, accepting, and respectful toward all persons; and

WHEREAS, School psychologists are trained to assess student and school-based barriers to learning and individual strengths, utilize data-based decision-making, implement research-driven prevention and intervention strategies, and evaluate outcomes and improve accountability; and

WHEREAS, Clay County District Schools should recognize the vital role that School Psychologists play in the personal and academic development of our District's children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the School Board of Clay County, Florida, does hereby proclaim November 7-11, 2022 as National School Psychologist Week.
