# Reopening of Schools



- As the District begins to create reopening of school plans for the 2020-2021 school year, input from our parents, students, and staff will be valued in the development of the plans. **Survey window is open through Monday, June 8th!**
- The district is currently working on creating a task force to draft plans for varying scenarios of reopening schools next fall.
- With Governor DeSantis' announcement of moving into Phase II on Friday, we are finalizing a plan to safely bring back our 11 and 12 month employees this summer.



## Summer Programs:

- Summer School will remain virtual
- VPK will be face-to-face with 12 children on site, one teacher, and one aide at FIE
  - The summer VPK session begins on Tuesday, June 9th with extra health, safety, and cleaning precautions in place
  - This is a 300 hour mandate per state statute and needed to be face-to-face for funding in partnership with Episcopal Children Services
- Planning for reopening campuses week of June 15th for band camps, sports conditioning, and sports tryouts, based on approved plans by Emergency Management and DOH-Clay County
