APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE/NOTICE OF THE INTENT TO ADOPT A REVISED CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT

Approval to Advertise: The School Board of Clay County, Florida ("the Board") approves the advertisement of a revised 2018-2019 Code of Student Conduct.

Purpose & Effect: The proposed revisions pertain to the implementation of the state and school district policies and procedures regarding K-12 student conduct.

Access to Text of Proposed Amendments: The full text of the proposed revisions to the Code of Student Conduct is available for inspection and copying by the public in the Office of the Superintendent for Clay County District Schools, located at 900 Walnut Street, Green Cove Springs, Florida 32043. The full text is also available via the School District's website at http://agenda.oneclay.net/content/files/18-19-code-of-conduct-redline-draft.pdf The Superintendent is authorized to correct technical errors in grammar, numbering, section designations, and cross-references as may be necessary to reflect the intention of such revisions.

Rule Making Authority: The Board is authorized to adopt the proposed revisions under sections 120.54, 1001.31, and 1001.32 of the Florida Statutes, and Rule 6A-6.034.11 of the Florida Administrative Code.

Laws Implemented: The laws implemented by the above-referenced Code of Student Conduct are noted within the manual.

Person(s) Originating Policy Changes: The proposed amendments were originated by the Assistant Superintendent for Climate and Culture in collaboration with multiple district staff and community partners.

Public Hearing: The Board intends to formally adopt the revised 2018-2019 Code of Student Conduct following a public hearing. *The public hearing shall be held on Thursday, August 2, 2018,* during the course of the Board's regular meeting, which begins *at 6:00 p.m.* and takes place in the Board Room at the Teacher In-service Training Center at Fleming Island High School, 2233 Village Square Parkway, Orange Park, Florida.
