Fees Required:

- Enrichment Facility Hourly Rate
- Utility Fees (not including restrooms)
- Salary/Benefits Costs
- Sale tax (if exempt form is not provided)

DEFINITION OF ENRICHMENT PROGRAM:

An enrichment activity is an experience where kids can extend their learning to improve or enhance skills, knowledge, and well-being. They help provide children with a rounded, culturally rich education through activities that enhance their learning, give them opportunities to try new and varied activities that may not strictly fit into the curriculum, but that develop character, resilience, and motivation, and encourage them to pursue wider goals.
