## CCSB and OPMC Partnership 2017-2018

## **Memorandum of Understanding**

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to clarify CCSB and OPMC commitments and agreements.

#### **District Commitment:**

The District is devoted to supporting the development of community partnerships to promote school and school-related event capacity.

- Access to elementary schools Tuesday folders four times per year. CCSB will provide a list to OPMC with the number of students at each of the schools.
- Transportation of Tuesday folder materials to individual elementary schools.
- Access to school district online media presence eight times per year.
  - OPMC may disseminate information once per month, up to eight times per year, through the school district's online media avenues. Media avenues for the purposes of this agreement shall be the school district website; the school district facebook page; the school district twitter account; and the school district employee email (including the weekly clay connection).
  - OPMC may chose, at its discretion, which media avenue they wish to utilize in any given month. An advertisement on the school district website shall run for an entire month on one webpage (chosen by OPMC) and will be either a side- or bottom-page banner at the school district's discretion and based on existing content for the chosen page. For all other designated media avenues, the school district shall publish or distribute OPMC's content once during weekday business hours.
  - Content to be distributed through the school district's online media avenues shall have a public-interest purpose and may not be strictly commercial in nature.
  - Content to be distributed through the school district's online media avenues shall be provided to the Superintendent's office at least two weeks prior to the requested distribution date for content approval.
- Each event, as much as possible, will include "Orange Park Medical Center", name in any advertisement (newspapers) and logo on fliers/handouts that are distributed. Public relations at CCSB will provide this information to local media.
- OPMC may set up a table/tent at the event and distribute information/materials to attendees.
- CCSB will be responsible for creating a banner to be displayed at sponsored events.

## **Memorandum of Understanding**

#### Statement:

This Memorandum of Understanding, created by the Clay County School Board (CCSB) and Orange Park Medical Center (OPMC), renews the Partnership Program between our two organizations for the purpose of promoting and supporting community partnerships at school and district-based events during the 2017-2018 school year.

#### **OPMC Commitment:**

- Financial support in the sum of \$30,000.00
- It is the responsibility of OPMC to supply all materials for the Tuesday folders. Materials to be distributed must be provided to the Superintendent's office at least two weeks prior to the requested delivery date for content approval.
- OPMC will breakdown materials to be distributed through Tuesday folders by school, label each accordingly, and contact CCSB for pick up and distribution of materials.
- OPMC agrees to organize hospital field trips (i.e. Teddy Bear Clinics) and shall provide transportation for the following five schools:
  - Charles E. Bennett Elementary
  - Clay Hill Elementary
  - Doctor's Inlet Elementary
  - Montclair Elementary

- OPMC shall provide, when feasible, pediatric giveaways as an in-kind donation to CCSB when requested by the Superintendent's office. Pediatric giveaways shall be used at school district events.
