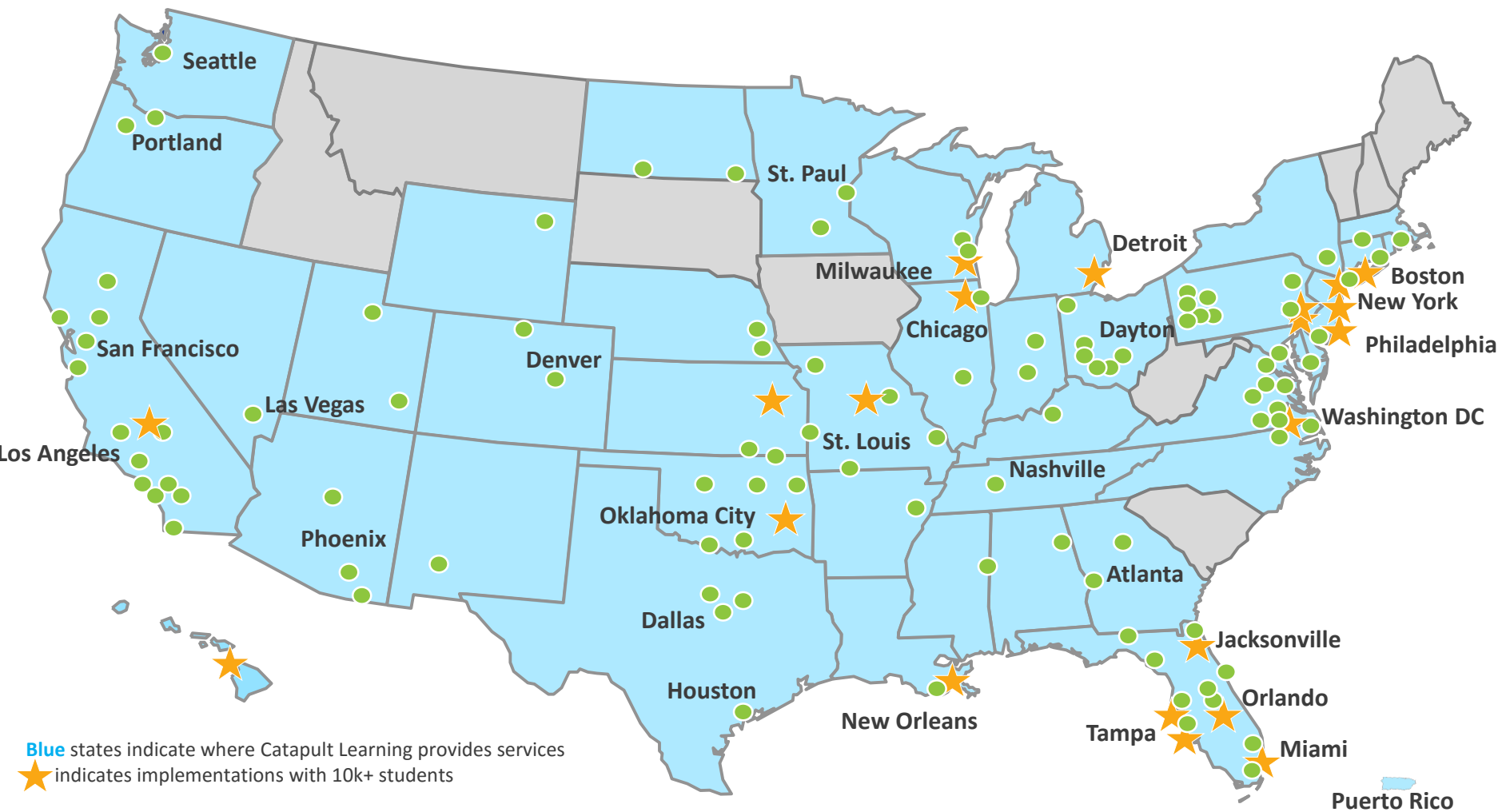

Students strive to not only earn a high school diploma but to be a 5-Star Graduate. A 5-Star Graduate is an accomplished individual who achieves all of the following:

- HS Diploma
- College Readiness Scores in Reading and/or Math on the ACT, SAT, or College Placement Exam (per State Statute)
- Applied to One College, for One Scholarship, and for the FAFSA
- Earn a statewide/nationally recognized Industry Certification
- Complete a minimum of 25+ hours of internship or volunteering
 - 5 Star Diploma – Meets all of the above
 - 4 Star Diploma – Meets any 4 of the above (Diploma HAS to be one)
 - 3 Star Diploma – Meet any 3 of the above (Diploma HAS to be one)
 - 2 Star Diploma – Meet any 2 of the above (Diploma HAS to be one)
 - 1 Star Diploma – Earn a HS Diploma and none of the other items above
