Education Facility Infrastructure Restricted Sales Tax

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AND PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD IN CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, TO DETERMINE IF THE ELECTORS IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVE THE LEVY BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, OF A ONE-HALF CENT PER DOLLAR SALES SURTAX WHICH THE SCHOOL BOARD MUST SHARE WITH ELIGIBLE CHARTER SCHOOLS BASED ON THEIR PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF TOTAL DISTRICT ENROLLMENT, TO BE USED TO

FINANCE FUNDING OF FIXED CAPITAL EXPENDITURES OR FIXED CAPITAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION OR IMPROVE-MENT OF SCHOOL FACILITIES AND CAMPUSES WHICH HAVE A USEFUL LIFE EXPECTANCY OF FIVE (5) OR MORE YEARS AND ANY LAND ACQUISITION, LAND IMPROVEMENT, DESIGN, AND ENGINEERING COSTS RELATED THERETO, TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING COSTS OF PURCHASING. RETROFITTING AND PROVIDING TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION, INCLUDING HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE, FOR THE VARIOUS SITES WITHIN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, FOR SAFETY AND SECURITY IMPROVEMENTS, FOR SERVICING BOND INDEBTEDNESS TO FINANCE PROJECTS AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION AND BY CHARTER SCHOOLS

FOR ALLOWABLE USES AS SET FORTH IN S. 1013.62(4) F.S.; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF THE REFERENDUM ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR PLACES OF VOTING, INSPECTORS AND CLERKS; PROVIDING FOR AN OFFICIAL BALLOT; PROVIDING FOR ABSENTEE VOTING; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; PROVIDING FOR PRINTING OF BALLOTS; PROVIDING FOR REFERENDUM RESULTS; PROVIDING FOR REFERENDUM ELECTION PROCEDURE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

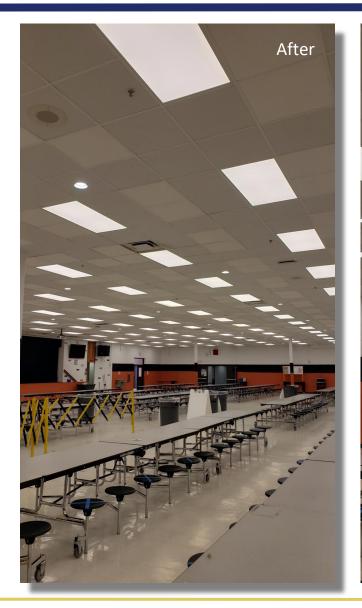
