**RESOLUTION CONDEMNING RACISM AND AFFIRMING
THE COMMITMENT OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY,
FLORIDA TO AN INCLUSIVE SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL**

The School Board of Clay County, Florida (“the Board”), acting as the governing body of the School District of Clay County, Florida (“the District”), finds as follows:

WHEREAS, members of The School Board of Clay County, are saddened and outraged by recent events that demonstrate injustice and inequity; and

WHEREAS, racism and hate have no place in our schools or our society, and we must protect the Constitutional rights of every person who lives, works and learns in our community; and

WHEREAS, we must act to stop injustice based on race, ethnicity, gender, socio-economic status, political affiliation, or zip code that harms and anguishes people who are our family, friends, neighbors, students, staff members, and fellow Americans; and

WHEREAS, education leaders are charged with ensuring that each of our children has equitable access to excellent educational opportunity; and


WHEREAS, no student should confront bias, harassment, prejudice, hatred, or discrimination in our schools or communities; and

WHEREAS, we must ensure that safe and enjoyable learning environments are established and maintained for all students in all communities; and






