

RESOLUTION # 17 - 20
National School Nurse Week May 6-12, 2017

KNOW ALL CITIZENS BY THESE PRESENTS, that the School Board of Clay County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereby recognizes the week of May 6-12, 2017 as “National School Nurse Week”, and encourages all residents to become aware of the significance and contribution that health care professionals have made toward the health and well-being of our students.

WHEREAS, providing a safe environment for students is the primary goal of the Clay County District Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Clay County District Schools recognize that health care professionals strengthen and facilitate the educational process by improving and protecting the health status of our students; and

WHEREAS, the Clay County District Schools recognize that our nation’s children face an increasing number of chronic and severe health problems from diabetes to asthma, seizures, obesity and depression, as well as other mental and physical health problems. Frequently, the only attention a child receives is through the school clinic; and

WHEREAS, the Clay County District Schools recognize that health care professionals support a large number of students by intervening with actual and potential health problems; collaborating with others to build student and family capacity for adaptation, self-management, self-advocacy, and learning; and

WHEREAS, these activities promoting the health and safety of students are important to the citizens of Clay County and others throughout the nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OFFICIAL SESSION, DULY ASSEMBLED IN FLEMING ISLAND, FLORIDA, THIS ____ DAY OF ____ 2017, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: The School Board of Clay County recognizes and honors the dedicated employees of Student Health Services; and

Section II: The School Board of Clay County, Florida, on behalf of all students and personnel, does hereby resolve to proclaim the week of May 6-12, 2017, as “National School Nurse Week” for the Clay County Schools; and

Section III: That a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the official minutes of the School Board of Clay County, Florida, distributed to all public schools and appropriate governmental bodies in Clay County, Florida.
