### Climate and Culture Student Survey Results



### **School Climate Survey:**

- Administered on Monday, November 29 - Friday, December 10, 2021
- 61.36% of CCDS students shared their opinions on the school climate survey
  - 10% increase over last year's survey
- Comprised of 17 questions for K-2 and 19 questions for 3-12



### **Topics Measured:**

- K-6: School connectedness, school safety, school orderliness, & peer and adult relations
- 7-12: School connectedness, school safety, school orderliness, peer and adult relations, teaching and learning, relationships, and safety



#### **Top Celebrations Amongst Our Students**:

- Having a trusted adult advocate at school
  - There is an adult at my school who will help me if I need it.
- School significance
  - I think school is important.
