Coronavirus Update

CLAY COUNTY DISTRICT SCHOOLS' CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PREPARATION FACT SHEET

Clay County District Schools is continuing to track updates regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in collaboration with the Florida Department of Health in Clay County and Clay County Emergency Management. In an effort to protect students and staff, Superintendent David Broskle has directed several actions for the district and schools to decrease the spread of respiratory illnesses like the Coronavirus.



- The District is prepared for extensive disinfecting of an impacted facility with a rapid response team should there be a confirmed case of Coronavirus.



STUDENT ATTENDANCE:

- Students or staff who become sick at school should be sent home as soon as possi
- · Normal school attendance policies remain in effect for all students.



- STUDENT AND EMPLOYEE TRAVEL: Any school-sponsored or o by the CDC will be canceled
- Any existing out-of-country travel that is not in a high-risk area will be review a case by case basis.
- Until further notice, new out-of-country and out-of-state travel requests will not be approved.



OTHER DIRECTIVES:

- The District is working to find the best way to deliver instruction if a student or school is required to stay home by the direction of the Department of Health.















- Increased cleaning by custodial staff
- Normal student attendance policies remain in effect
- School-sponsored or district-sponsored travel to areas deemed to be high-risk by the CDC will be canceled
- The District Coordinator of Nursing Services is continuing to update Health Room Nurses daily on any changes
- The District will take direction from the Department of Health should there be a confirmed case of Coronavirus in our county
