# 2020- 2021 Student Breakdown



## Clay Virtual Academy Enrollment in FOCUS by August 6, 2020

K-5 Students - 682

6th grade Students - 140

7th- 12th grade Students - 1,264

Total = 2,086

\*Another 300+ students are still waiting to complete  
Registration for CVA (immunization records, birth certif., proof  
of residency, etc.)





## **OneClay Online (OCO)**

**Enrollment in FOCUS by August 5, 2020:**

K-6 Students - 4,015

7th- 8th Students - 963

9th- 12th grade Students - 1,443

Total = 6,421

## **Home Education Enrollment**

2019-2020 - 1,415 Students

2020- 2021- 1,696 Students = 281 increase in Home Ed
