




COVID-19 Testing & FLDOE Decision- Tree



Return to School COVID-19 Guidance does allow students to test out early from quarantine with a negative result and if asymptomatic.



Students seeking clearance for early return after exposure must do so with an approved negative test from a provider and be exhibiting no COVID-19 symptoms. Students must receive clearance from the school nurse by meeting the criteria on the Early Return form per DOH-Clay. A parent/guardian needs to be present for clearance check before the student can return to in-person learning.



Students will receive notification from DOH-Clay that details the earliest date that students may test and the brand/type of test that may be utilized for early return to school through a medical provider.

Emergency Management, students
and employees can receive a free
PCR test at Omega Park through a
designated "Fast Pass" line. Students
and Employees will need to bring their
school or work ID for proof.



COVID-19 Safety Reminders

Please DO NOT come to school or work if you fall into one of the following scenarios:

- You are awaiting COVID-19 test results (regardless if asymptomatic)
- You are a confirmed positive with COVID-19 and still within the recommended self-isolation timeframe (regardless of vaccination status)
- Someone in the home is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms and is awaiting test results (*Unless fully vaccinated and showing no symptoms)
- Someone in the home is positive with COVID-19 (*Unless fully vaccinated and showing no symptoms - highly encourage use of face covering)
- You have been contact traced and directed to quarantine from the Department of Health or medical provider
