

## **Coppergate Elementary as a Visual and Performing Arts School**

## NEED FOR CHOICE IN CLAY:

89% of elementary parents surveyed believe that the arts are a very important or important part of their children's education. Arts and Gifted & Talented programs are two of the top five Choice programs elementary parents selected from the School Choice survey. In addition, STEAM is the number one Choice program indicated on the survey. Coppergate Elementary can infuse the "A" in STEAM throughout all content areas thereby leading a logical feeder pattern from elementary to junior high. CGE has a 68% free and reduced lunch population. Americans for the Arts says that "low-income students who are highly engaged in the arts are twice as likely to graduate college as their peers with no arts education". In addition, Coppergate Elementary is centrally located in the district which allows more students and parents to benefit.
