Clay Hill Elementary

Principal: Adele Reed



Clay Hill Elementary had the highest ELA learning gains in the lower quartile in the district at 69%, an increase of 34 points from 2021

- ELA learning gains rose by 17 points
- Math learning gains rose by 23 points



Doctors Inlet Elementary

Principal: Carolyn Ayers



Doctors Inlet also had the highest Math learning gains in the lower quartile in the district at 76% - an increase of 26 points from 2021.



Lake Asbury Elementary

Principal: Tiffany Outman



Lake Asbury Elementary earned a A for the first time since 2015

- ELA learning gains in the lower quartile rose by 13 points
- Math learning gains rose by 18 points
- Math learning gains in the lower quartile rose by 24 points



Lakeside Elementary

Principal: Dawn Wolfe



Lakeside had the highest 6th grade Math achievement and learning gains in the district.

- 93% Proficiency
- 97% Learning Gains
- 97% Learning Gains in the Lower Quartile



Paterson Elementary

Principal: John O'Brian



Paterson is the #1 ranked elementary school in the district.

- Math learning gains in the lower quartile rose by 36 points
- Math learning gains rose by 19 points



Plantation Oaks Elementary

Principal: Kim Marks



Plantation Oaks Elementary earned a A for the first time since 2015

- ELA learning gains in the lower quartile rose by 5 points
- Math learning gains in the lower quartile rose by 8 points



S. Bryan Jennings Elementary

Principal: Elise Taylor



S. Bryan Jennings Elementary increased 114 points from 2021

- ELA learning gains in the lower quartile rose by 38 points
- ELA learning gains rose by 24 points
- Math learning gains rose by 20 points



Lakeside Junior High

Principal: Rodney Ivey



Lakeside is the #1 ranked junior high school in the district.

- Civics achievement was 92%, 23 points above state average
- Science achievement was 82%, 34 points above state average



Orange Park High

Principal: Ivin Gunder



Orange Park High increased 57 points from 2021

Orange Park High also had the highest Math learning gains in the lower quartile of all high schools - up 20 points from last year
