Distance Learning by the Numbers from April 1:

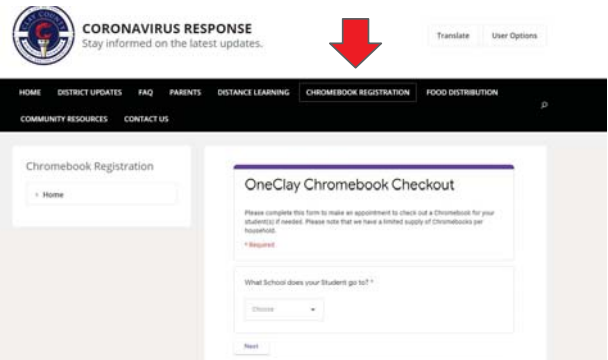
- **OneClay Portal:** over 72,000 logins

As of April 1, the district has served:

- 1,318 students breakfast
- 3,094 students lunch

Totaling 4,412 meals!



Please see the following guidelines regarding meal pick-up:

- Anyone 18 years or younger can receive a meal
- Student must be present to receive a meal
- Meals are served curbside to minimize contact
- Breakfast is served from 8:00-9:00 and lunch is served 12:00-1:00.
Starting April 17th, students will receive a hot lunch and a cold breakfast for the next day. This will eliminate parents from making two trips. Meal service times will be from 11:00-1:00.
- Meals can only be served on days when school was originally scheduled. We will not be providing meals on April 3rd (Fair Day) and April 10th (Good Friday).

School Social Workers Outreach



School Social Workers:

- will be collaborating with other mental health clinicians in the district to produce 30 second videos that demonstrate a stress/anxiety reducing activity or strategy. These can be included in weekly communications from teachers and posted to our own Coronavirus site.
- working with families in need regarding Chromebook delivery and meal distribution through “drop” visits to adhere to physical distancing.
- working with community partners to identify resources for food, housing, childcare, financial assistance, etc.
- monitoring and responding to needs of school staff in offering support and encouragement.



School Closures Update



- **School Closures Timeline**

- March 13th: FLDOE Closed all School Districts until March 30th
- March 17th: FLDOE Closed all School Districts until April 15th
- March 30th: FLDOE Closed all School Districts through May 1st
- May 4th: Tentative Date to Return to School Sites

- **School Grades**

- School Districts will not receive School Grades for school year 2019-2020



- **State Assessments Cancelled**

- 3rd Grade Reading FSA has been Waived for Promotion
- 10th Grade Reading FSA & Alg. I EOC have been Waived for Seniors
- Non-Seniors taking Alg. I can take Geometry EOC next year and pass, which will satisfy the Alg. I requirements or take the SAT/ACT for a concordant score.

- **Accelerated Assessments**

- AP
 - Traditional face-to-face exam administrations will not take place. Students will take a 45-minute online free-response exam at home.
 - Some students may want to take the exam sooner rather than later, while the content is still fresh. Other students may want more time to practice. For each AP subject, there will be 2 different testing dates. The full exam schedule, specific free-response question types that will be on each AP Exam, and additional testing details will be available by April 3.



- **Accelerated Assessments (Continued)**

- Cambridge

- Cambridge will not run international exams in the May/June 2020 series. Schools will make evidence-based decisions about grades. Students that still wish to take exams can do so during the November 2020 exam series. All certificates from Cambridge International, including the AICE Diploma, will be awarded as in past years.

- International Baccalaureate

- The DP and CP examinations scheduled between April 30th - May 22nd will no longer be held.
- The student will be awarded either a diploma or a course certificate which reflects their standard of work.
- The achievement will be based around the students' coursework and the established assessment expertise, rigor and quality control already built into the programs.
