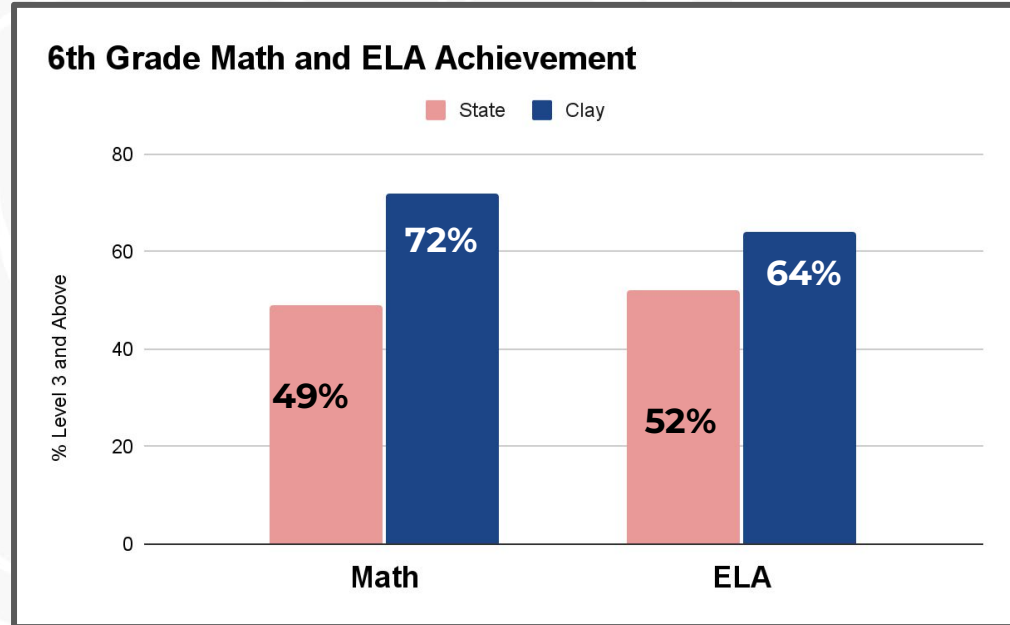

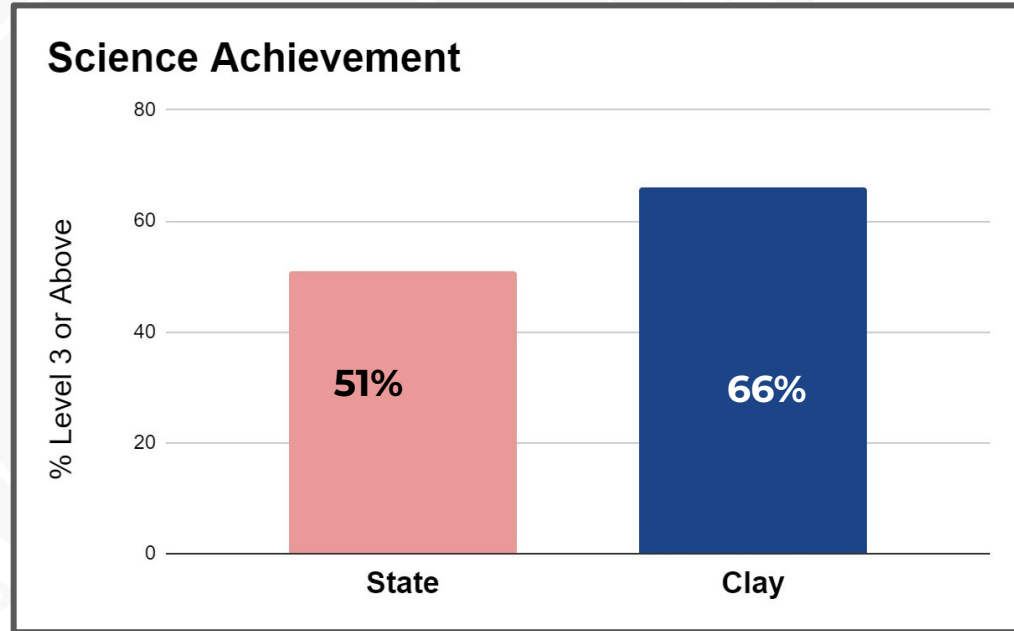

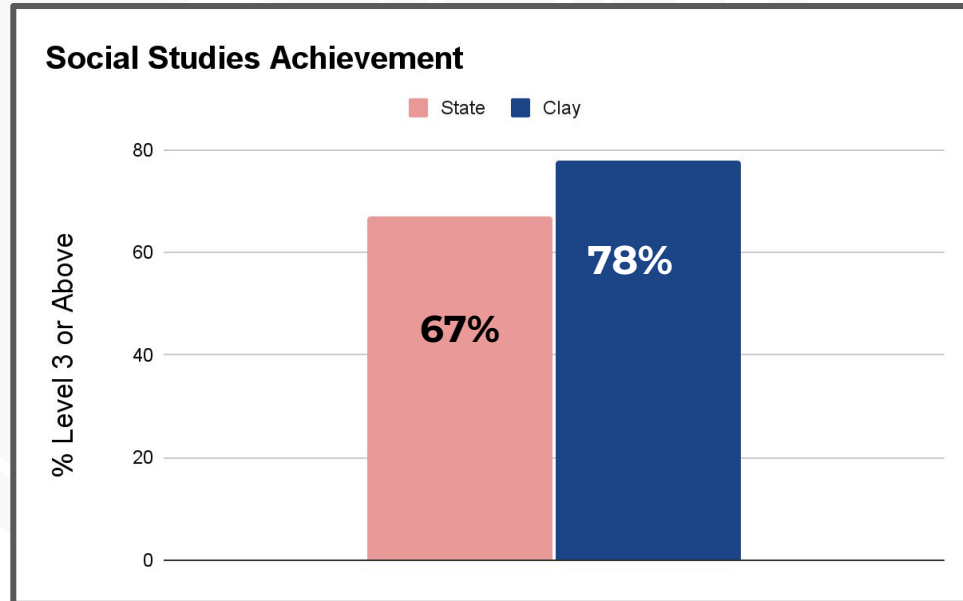

Find Your School Zone

For security reasons parents are required to create a BusPlanner Web account using an email address to find your student's routing information. After creating the account the email address must be verified before adding students, so please check your spam/junk mail folder. You will now be able to add your children to the account. From then on you will only have to login once to see all of their children's transportation information.

Please Note: In creating a new student they are asking for the "Street Number" not the whole address.

Food and Nutrition Meal Applications

Waivers have expired.

The Federal COVID waivers we have been operating under for the past two years have expired. In order to receive free or reduced meals, parents will need to complete a new application. Please remember that a new application must be completed for each school year. The reduced price for lunch is \$.40 and breakfast is \$.30.

We are pleased to announce that we will not be raising meal prices for the 2022-23 school year. Elementary lunch prices are \$2.25 and secondary are \$2.50. Breakfast prices are \$1.50.

Children attending a Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school will not need to complete a Free and Reduced Application. Each CEP school will provide both breakfast and lunch at no charge with no application process. If a child attends a non-CEP school, a free or reduced price meal application must be completed to receive benefits. Households with children attending a CEP school and a non-CEP school will need to complete a meal application. Because the number of household members is a qualification of eligibility, the number of children in the household is also a factor.

Entry Requirements for Kindergarten and 7th Graders



Immunization Requirements

Before entering or attending school in-person or virtually (kindergarten through twelfth grade), the Florida Department of Health requires that each child provide a Florida **Certification of Immunization**.

Students entering or attending 7th grade also need an updated form showing the **Tdap**.




