Purpose:

Provides a forum for students to have direct communication and interaction with the Superintendent to discuss strategies to improve the education experiences in Clay County District Schools.

Eligibility:

- ➤ Any 7th-12th Grade Student (Taking two Scholars per grade)
- > Students Must be Enrolled in Clay County District Schools
- ➤ Must complete the SSAC Application Process
- > If selected for an interview, must provide recommendations
- Must obtain Parent/Guardian Approval

Deadline for Application:

June 1st, 2018

Benefits:

- > Engage an active voice for improving our district.
- ➤ Develop important leadership, public speaking, decision-making and team building skills.
- ➤ Gain a network of supporters and mentors through exposure to Clay County District Schools and Clay County civic leaders.

Requirements

- Serve an eight-month term that begins in September and concludes in May of each academic year;
- ➤ Participate in monthly meetings with the Superintendent, bi-monthly leadership development workshops, and other special events;
- Provide input on upcoming policy decisions and best practices



Benefits for In-School SAT

- > SAT School Day allows us to offer the SAT to Juniors and Seniors in school, during the school day.
 - Provides students with the opportunity to show colleges they're ready.
 - Provides the opportunity for seniors to meet the reading requirement for graduation with 50% extra time
 - Eliminates logistical barriers and provides equity access

SAT School Day Results


On March 7, 2018, Clay County High Schools participated in the first-ever SAT School Day administration.
