ESE Fast Facts in Clay County

- ★ Clay County serves almost 11,000 ESE students from ages 3-21 spread across all of our schools.
- ★ We also serve hundreds of students through related services such as Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Mental Health Counseling, Specially Designed Physical Education, etc.
- ★ Transition services are available for students through age 21 who defer graduation in order to engage in career training and life skills.




ESE Graduation Rates


