MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING 2017-2018 ACADEMIC YEAR CLAY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD-UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA

The University of North Florida provides early field experiences, called pre-internships, for those preparing to be teachers. During pre-internship, students are assigned to a school and are actively engaged in a variety of experiences designed to help them understand the real world of the classroom and practice newly acquired teaching skills.

The Clay County Schools and the University of North Florida College of Education and Human Services (COEHS) agree to cooperatively participate in the Field Laboratory Pre-internship Program during the 2017-2018 academic year. This program will provide the Clay County School District with an opportunity to recognize excellence in teaching, provide professional growth for exemplary teachers, and provide assistance in addressing educational issues deemed critical by the school district.

At the same time this program provides an opportunity for the University to improve its partnership program by forging stronger linkages with the participating school system and by providing opportunities for exemplary teachers to work with those preparing to enter the profession.

Participation will involve the following:

- 1) By the summer 2017 term, the COEHS and officials to be designated by the Clay County School District will collaboratively identify two experienced, exemplary teachers to serve as Field Laboratory Clinical Educators for the 2017-2018 academic year.
- 2) During the 2017-2018 academic year, each selected Field Laboratory Clinical Educator will hold a courtesy appointment as an Instructor, participate in a wide variety of professional growth activities, receive training in the areas of clinical supervision, action research, and various instructional strategies that are integrated into the Field Lab model. These teachers and others will constitute a professional cadre who will research, propose, and implement strategies to address identified issues in the district. Each Field Lab teacher will direct pre-interns as they participate in field experiences through the use of on-site observation and on campus seminars. In addition, they may serve as an instructor in other related courses. The Field Laboratory Pre-Internship Program will be coordinated collaboratively by the Director of Educational Field Experiences and the appropriate department chairperson(s).
- 3) Each Field Laboratory Clinical Educator will remain a school district employee and not be an employee of the University. The University agrees to reimburse the Clay County School District for one-half of each teacher's salary and benefits for the 2017-2018 contract year. It is understood that Field Laboratory Clinical Educators will work the same number of days specified in their regular contract, but they may require a modified schedule due to differences in the University and district calendars.
- 4) The Field Laboratory Pre-Internship Program will be evaluated by the University and Clay County School District Board staff to determine the impact on the pre-interns, the Field Laboratory Clinical Educators, and the district. Results will be disseminated to the district and to all members of the project.
- 5) The University of North Florida's College of Education and Human Services and the Clay County School District agree to collaboratively work to develop mutually beneficial field/clinical experiences designed to improve student learning and the preparation of teachers. To this end the parties agree to jointly:

- a. Establish goals and expectations for teacher candidates, school and university based clinical educators.
- b. Co select, orient and assess school based and university clinical educators.
- c. Develop criteria for selection of clinical educators that includes but is not limited to a minimum of three years classroom teaching experience, appropriate state certification, effective or highly effective on annual evaluations, and Clinical Educator Training.
- d. Provide professional development opportunities to enhance the knowledge and skill set of clinical educators.
- e. Create multiple performance evaluations and collaboratively utilize them for assessment purposes of candidates and clinical educators.
- f. Design diverse field/clinical experiences that demonstrate a high degree of depth, breadth, and are of sufficient duration to permit candidates to develop the knowledge, skills, and dispositions to become effective and positively impact student learning.
- g. Regularly meet to discuss field experiences and make suggestions about the programs that prepare candidates to be effective in their field placements.
- h. Regularly meet to discuss field experiences and make suggestions about the impact that interns are having on pre-K--12 students.
- i. Regularly meet to discuss field experiences and make suggestions about the dispositions that candidates demonstrate during their field placements.
- 6) Clay County Schools shall allow public access to all documents, papers, letters or other material subject to the provisions of Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and made or received in connection with this Agreement.


