

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA DETERMINING THAT PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS BUILDING 95, ROOMS 501, 601, 701 AND 801 AT THE MIDDLEBURG TRANSPORTATION FACILITY, 3674 C.R. 220, MIDDLEBURG, FLORIDA ARE NO LONGER ELIGIBLE BY CODE ENFORCEMENT FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AND WOULD REQUIRE EXTENSIVE REPAIRS FOR ANCILLARY PURPOSES AND HAVE NO COMMERCIAL VALUE AND SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF BY THE MOST ECONOMIC MEANS.

WHEREAS, The School Board of Clay County, Florida wants to dispose of the structures described as relocatable building 95, Rooms 501, 601, 701 and 801 located at the Middleburg Transportation Facility: and

WHEREAS, the structures have deteriorated, are not cost effective to repair, are no longer utilized, serve no useful function and are without commercial value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statue 1013.28 requires a determination that said structures are unusable for educational purposes and ancillary purposes and have no commercial value;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the School Board to dispose of said property by most economical means of Clay County School District Personnel;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the School District of Clay County, Florida, that the following described property is unusable for education and ancillary purposes and is without commercial value and in the best interest of the public, should be disposed of by the most economic means. Said property is more particularly described as follows:

Structures: Building 95, Rooms 501, 601, 701 and 801, are relocatable wooden buildings constructed in 1963, 1963, 1964 and 1964 respectively, currently at the Middleburg Transportation Facility, 3674 C.R. 220, Middleburg, Florida.
