

Items to Look at for Determining Student Enrollment:

- Numbers from "Mapping / Boundary Planning Projected Enrollment."
- Projections turned in by Principal.
- "Monthly Membership" from year-to-year."
- Discuss any trends with facilities.
- Discussions with Principals about their school zone.
- "Roll Up" numbers from previous grade level.
- Are there any special programs at the school? Adding any programs?
 - Academies, IB, AICE, "Unknowns", etc.

Items to Look at for Determining Student Enrollment:

- Special Pupil Requests (SPR's).
- Estimates from Clay Virtual Academy.
- Dropout Rate: 1% 3% consideration.
- Economy and county growth rate impacts school numbers.
- Process: Principals turn in numbers to Secondary Education, which adjusts and forwards to Asst. Superintendent/Deputy Superintendent and more discussions ensue.
- Final number is settled.

- PROCESS:
 - REVIEW ENROLLMENT NUMBERS.
 - REVIEW PROGRAMS AT SCHOOL
 - JUNIOR HIGH OR HIGH SCHOOL (Look at JH Example)
 - ✓ Class Size Requirement 22 for Junior High
