On the listed date and time I was dispatched to 2752 Moody Av (Lakeside Elementary School) in reference to a burglary. Upon my arrival I made contact with Amanda Davis, a fifth grade teacher at the school.

Ms Davis said that her classroom, portable 12, had been burglarized and items were stolen. The unknown suspect(s) lifted the window next to the front door and climbed inside the portable. Once inside the unknown suspect(s) took a Dell computer monitor and a Dell computer tower. The total value of the items taken from portable 12 is approximately \$850.00.

The unknown suspect(s) went around the school attempting to enter additional portables. The unknown suspect(s) would pry the bottom of the screen on the windows to check if the window was left unlocked. When the suspect(s) pried the screen it bent the bottom of them. The suspect(s) attempted to get into portables 11, 13, 14, 24, 26, 27, 47, 51A, and 51B. The suspects(s) also cut the lock on a P.E. storage shed in an attempt to gain access inside, but were unable to make entry.

I then went to check Lakeside Junior High School which is on the same campus as the elementary school. Once at the Junior High I noticed that portables 703, 704, 705, 706, and 721 had the same damage to the screens as the elementary school. I made contact with Randy Oliver, principal, who said that the unknown suspect(s) had gained entry into portable 791 and building 20. I did notice a clean box of matches lying on the ground outside of portable 705.

The unknown suspect(s) gained entry into portable 791 through an unlocked window. Once inside portable 791 the suspect(s) took a Dell 7100 printer (value \$100.00), a Sony cd player (\$30.00), a two Kenwood two way radios (value \$300.00), and a Dell computer (value \$972.62), serial number 1S9SL91. The Dell computer was entered into NCIC as stolen by ECO White #6863.

At building 20 the suspect(s) cut a lock of a gate on the side of the building. The suspect(S) then entered the fenced in area and locked a small hole in the wall that was covered by a wooden board. The suspect(s) pushed the wood board out of the way to enter the building. Once inside the suspect(s) removed a Stihl edger (\$250.00), and a Weed Eater hedge trimmer (value \$100.00).

Deputy Kirchner arrived on the scene and took photographs and processed the portables for evidence. Deputy Schueler arrived on scene and assisted with taking photographs of the portables. Sgt. Edwin Eisenhower responded to the scene and notified Y.R.U.

Juvenile Crime Section Detective K. Rodgers arrived on the scene and assumed the investigation.

I collected the cut lock from the Elementary School as well as the box of matches from outside portable 705 at Lakeside Junior High School.

This case is active pending transfer to Y.R.U.

ON 11/4/02 AT APPROXIMATELY 1000 HOURS, I RESPONDED TO THE MIDDLEBURG HIGH SCHOOL IN REFERENCE TO THIS INVESTIGATION. UPON ARRIVAL, I MET WITH D/S MARKLE IN REFERENCE TO THIS INCIDENT. UPON CONTACT, D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT THE INCIDENT OCCURRED APPROXIMATELY SIX (6) DAYS BEFORE AND THAT SCHOOL OFFICIALS HAD WAITED FOR THE PROPERTY TO BE RETURNED PRIOR TO CONTACTING THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT A PRIMARY SUSPECT HAD BEEN IDENTIFIED THROUGH HIS CONTACT WITH NUMEROUS STUDENTS. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT THE PRIMARY SUSPECT'S NAME IS [REDACTED] [REDACTED] D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT [REDACTED] IS A STUDENT IN AUTO MECHANICS, GETTING HIM ACCESS AND POSSIBLE KNOWLEDGE OF THE STOLEN ITEMS. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT THE ITEMS STOLEN WERE SPECIFIC TO THE AUTO MECHANICS FIELD. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT HE WOULD POSSIBLY BE ABLE TO FIND OUT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE INCIDENT THROUGH SEVERAL STUDENTS THAT ROUTINELY GIVE HIM INFORMATION. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT HE WOULD CONTACT ME IF HE GAINED ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.

AT APPROXIMATELY 1300 HOURS, D/S MARKLE RECONTACTED ME AT THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND REQUESTED THAT I RETURN TO THE SCHOOL. UPON MY ARRIVAL, D/S MARKLE HAD THE SUSPECT AND A POSSIBLE WITNESS, [REDACTED] IN THE FRONT OFFICE. BOTH WERE INTERVIEWED ABOUT THEIR KNOWLEDGE OF OR INVOLVEMENT IN THE INCIDENT. BOTH DENIED ANY INVOLVEMENT IN THE INCIDENT. THE SUSPECT ADVISED THAT HE HAD HEARD OF THE INCIDENT AND HAD SPOKEN TO SEVERAL PEOPLE ABOUT IT BUT AGAIN CLAIMED NOT TO KNOW WHO HAD COMMITTED THE THEFT.

ON 11/8/02, I AGAIN RESPONDED TO THE MIDDLEBURG HIGH SCHOOL IN REFERENCE TO THIS INCIDENT. UPON ARRIVAL, I SPOKE WITH D/S MARKLE. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT NONE OF THE STUDENTS WHOM REGULARLY GIVE HIM INFORMATION HAD COME FORWARD WITH NEW INFORMATION ABOUT THE CASE. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT THE STUDENTS HAD ONLY GIVEN HIM THE SAME INFORMATION AS BEFORE, INDICATING THAT [REDACTED] HAD COMMITTED THE THEFT.

I THEN REQUESTED THAT D/S MARKLE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE SUSPECT TO MEET ME AT THE CLAY COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MIDDLEBURG OPERATIONS CENTER REFERENCE TO AN INTERVIEW. D/S MARKLE ADVISED THAT HE WOULD MAKE CONTACT WITH THE SUSPECT AND HAVE HIM RESPOND TO THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IMMEDIATELY AFTER SCHOOL.

SHORTLY AFTER LEAVING THE MIDDLEBURG HIGH SCHOOL, I WAS RECONTACTED BY D/S MARKLE




