SUBJECT: Character Based Abstinence Education Annual results for 8th and 9th graders.

Project SOS, Inc. fulfilled the following activities in order to teach all 8th and 9th graders the benefits and skills of postponing sexual activity and avoiding drugs and alcohol:

1. Mailed home parent newsletter to all 8th and 9th grade parents
 2. Taught programs to all 8th and 9th graders in Life Management classes or auditoriums
 3. Distributed student health packets to all participants
 4. Held bi-monthly SOS Clubs (Strengthening Our Students) in each of the middle & high schools throughout the school year.
- In clubs, teens were mentored and taught how to set boundaries, avoid unhealthy relationships, set future goals, use refusal skills effectively and respect themselves and others.
