- Fully implement Florida State Standards for ELA and Math
- Administer the new Florida Standards Assessment
- Require all students in grades 4-11 to take the writing assessment
- Develop and implement local assessments to measure student performance in grades and subjects not covered by a statewide assessment
- Implement a new school grading system
- Expand the use of technology in the classroom and for online assessments

- Math will require students to use digital tools
- Technology skills have not been emphasized due to focus on learning the new standards.
