## **RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THAT THE CLAY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COUNTY BOARD OF GRANT VOTING STATUS TO THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, COUNTY PLANNING ON THE CLAY SERVING ALLOWING SAID COMMISSION, THEREBY REPRESENTATIVE TO VOTE ONLY ON REZONING WHICH MAY GRANTING OF PETITIONS, THE **DENSITY** OR CAUSE RESIDENTIAL INCREASE RESIDENTIAL REDISTRIBUTION IN THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 163.3174 requires that the governing body of each local government establish a local planning agency, and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 163.3174 requires that each local planning agency include a representative of the School District appointed by the School Board as a non-voting member, and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 163.3174 does not prohibit or prevent the governing body of the local government from granting voting status to the School Board member included on the local planning agency, and

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of County Commissioners has established a local planning agency known as the Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Clay County Planning Commission of the Clay County Board of County Commissioners has included a representative of the School District on said commission as a non-voting member, and

WHEREAS, members of the School Board of Clay County, Florida, hold the opinion that their interest, as well as those of the citizens of Clay County, Florida, would be best served if the representative of the School Board of Clay County, Florida, on the Clay County Board of County Commissioners' local Planning Commission was given the status of a voting member,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the School Board of Clay County, Florida, hereby requests that the Clay County Board of County Commissioners grant voting status to the representative of the School Board of Clay County, Florida, serving on the Clay

County Planning Commission, thereby allowing said representative to vote only on rezoning petitions and other matters which come before the Planning Commission, the granting of which may increase residential density or cause residential redistribution in the county.
