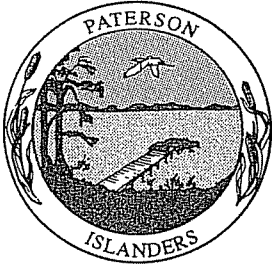


On 12/11/06 at 0824 hours, I responded to Montclair Elementary in reference to a burglary. Upon arrival, I spoke to Bill Miller(reporting party) who is the principal at the school. He advised me that someone got into three portable classrooms and stole three computers and a printer.

Investigation revealed that the unknown subject(s) got into the portable classrooms with no force. It is believed that the subject(s) may have a master key to the portables. Once inside the subject(s) unplugged a Dell computer tower leaving all the wires and accessories behind just taking the tower itself. The subject(s) did this to three portable classrooms: #34 (1) Dell cpu tower, #37 (1) Dell cpu tower, and (1) Dell laser printer, and #38 (1) Dell cpu tower. In portable #37 it was found that the subject(s) took some skittles candy from a jar.

Deputy Weiss#0329 responded and processed the scene. He took photos of the classrooms and also dusted the candy jar for latent prints. It is unknown at this time who maybe responsible. Contact was made with NCIC operator Olohan #6078 and all stolen items were entered as stolen property.

This case is pending further investigation.



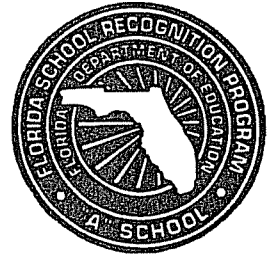

This officer was called to respond to the Clay County School Board, to meet with Darlene Mahla, victim 1, in reference to her vehicle having been broken into. Upon arrival, contact was made with victim 1 who advised her 1996 green Ford Explorer, was parked in her driveway, located at 222 Eventide Dr., around 2300 hours, unlocked. She left for work this morning and did not discover the burglary until she arrived at work and realized her cell phone, camera and gift cards were missing. Victim 1 prepared a written statement advising the same.

Victims 1's Nextel, valued at \$285.00, phone number is 904-759-9655, unknown serial number, has already been turned off. The camera was a Mavica digital video/still camera, serial number 411199, valued at \$550, it was black in color and in a large black vinyl case 15x12x10. There was a total of two JC Penney gift cards for \$15.00 each. Both were in red envelopes, one had the name Banks Ready on it, the other, Keelan Ready. There were also two Sonic gift cards at \$10.00 each.

I then relocated to victim 1's residence wherein an additional burglary to auto was discovered involving their other vehicle, a 2001 white Ford F-150 truck. A camouflage hunting jacket was taken from the tool box area, valued at \$50.00.

An additional burglary to auto was found at 234 Eventide Dr., and contact was made with that victim, Laura Hinson. Victim 2 advised her neighbor told her about their vehicles being broken into and she checked hers and found several items missing. Victim 2 stated she had a Sony or Audiovox brand, silver, portable DVD/CD player, 7 inch screen with two headphone sets, and charger in a black zippered case, valued at \$300.00. Five DVD movies, unknown titles, valued at \$100.00. A pair of white-gold, 1 and 1/2 kt diamond earrings, valued at \$3,000.00, in the center console. A written statement was obtained from victim 2.

I processed victim 2's vehicle and obtained several latent fingerprints, which were lifted and placed into evidence. A neighborhood canvass was conducted at 198, 210 and 246 Eventide Dr., with negative results as no one answered the doors, even though vehicles were in the driveways. No one was home at the other houses on this street.

Detective Bowman arrived on the scene and assumed the investigation.
