RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THAT PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS BUILDING 91, ROOM 55 AT ORANGE PARK HIGH SCHOOL, 2300 KINGSLEY AVENUE, ORANGE PARK, FLORIDA IS NO LONGER ELIGIBLE BY CODE ENFORCEMENT FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES OR ANCILLARY PURPOSES AND HAS NO COMMERCIAL VALUE AND SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF BY THE MOST ECONOMIC MEANS.

WHEREAS, The School Board of Clay County, Florida wants to dispose of the structure described as relocatable Building, Room #55, located at Orange Park High School: and

WHEREAS, the structure has deteriorated, is not cost effective to repair and is no longer utilized, serves no useful function and is without commercial value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statue 1013.28 requires a determination that said structure is unusable for educational purposes and ancillary purposes and has no commercial value;


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the School Board to dispose of said structure by the most economical means of Clay County District Personnel;
