Victim PLANTATION OAK ELEMENTY	Offense BURGLARY TO BUSINESS
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On 05-19-2014 I was dispatched to 4150 Plantation Oaks Blvd, Plantation Oaks Elementary School, in reference to a burglary.

Upon my arrival I made contact with custodian Mark Osborne. M. Osborne advised he arrived at the school at 0545Hrs and noticed the school had been burglarized. M. Osborne and myself walked around the school and noticed several windows had been broken, several fire extinguishers had been discharged and several other incidents of vandalism had been committed. M. Osborne and myself the proceeded outside and checked the portable classrooms. We noticed that several of the portables had the windows broken. The portable classrooms fiber optic data cables had been damaged as well. M. Osborne completed a sworn statement.

I found an exterior door on the east side of the main building that appeared to be the entry point to the school. The window on the exterior door was broken by an unknown object. Once inside the suspect(s) proceeded to break the windows to the following classrooms: 513, 709, 710, 722, 723. The suspect(s) only appeared to enter classrooms 722 and 723. Inside classroom # 722 the suspect(s) turned over the desks and threw the computer and printer on the ground causing damage. In classroom #723 the suspect(s) also turned over the desks and threw the computer and printer on the ground causing damage. The suspect(s) also poked holes in the wall with an unknown object. The suspect(s) also wrote "fuck u nigger" on the dry erase board in the classroom. In the hallway of the school the suspect(s) discharged 6 fire extinguishers and ripped several posters off the wall. The suspect(s) also damaged 3 hanging "EXIT" signs in the hallways.

I noticed that the following portables had broken windows: 905, 906, 908, 910, 912, 913, 915. These windows were broken with an unknown object. I observed the exterior fiber optic data cables were ripped out and damaged on the following portables: 910, 911, 912, 914.

D/S E. Adams responded and processed the scene.

During my search of the school I only noticed one set of shoe impressions in the powder left by the fire extinguisher. This shoe impression was observed walking throughout the school and was also observed around the portables outside. I did not locate any other physical evidence during my search. The school is not equipped with CCTV cameras.

M. Osborne advised me he spoke with teacher Duane Robbins who told him he was at the school on 05-18-2014 until 1600hrs and the school was not damaged at that time.

While on scene I was contacted by Jennifer Davis, (904)-614-5933, who lives at 3798 Pondview Dr. J. Davis stated at approximately 2030Hrs on 05-18-2014 she heard what she believes was glass breaking coming from the area of the school. J. Davis stated she did not call the Sheriffs Office at that time.

This case is transferred to the Juvenile Crime Section.
