

PEDIATRIC BEHAVIORAL SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT

THIS AMENDMENT entered into this 18th day of July, 2013, by and between THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, hereinafter referred to as “Board,” and PEDIATRIC BEHAVIORAL SERVICES, hereinafter referred to as the “Contractor.”

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2013, the parties entered into a contract for behavior analysis services for students with autism and other developmental disabilities; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that extended school year (ESY) services for Clay County students have been recommended, which services were not contemplated by the original contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree as follows:

1. One (1) student is in need of ESY services.
2. ESY shall take place two (2) days per week, three hours per day, and shall run from June 17, 2013 through July 17, 2013, for a total of eight days or twenty four (24) hours of direct therapy. Program development time may not exceed four (4) hours.
3. The rate per hour may not exceed \$60.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the above-referenced Contract as follows:

1. Extended school year (ESY) shall be provided to one (1) Clay County student by the Contractor.
2. ESY shall be provided two (2) days per week, three hours per day, beginning June 17, 2013, and ending on July 17, 2013, for a total of eight (8) days or twenty four

hours of direct therapy. Program development time may not exceed four (4) hours.

3. The rate per hour may not exceed \$60.00.
4. The Contract is amended to reflect the increase in the Board's payment obligation as set forth in the paragraph immediately preceding this paragraph.
5. All other terms and conditions of the Contract entered into by the parties on March 19, 2013, shall remain unchanged and shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Contract Amendment, nunc pro tunc, to March 19, 2013.
