## GRANT OF EASEMENT

 (Drainage)THIS EASEMENT made as of the $\qquad$ day of July, 2006, by and between PINE RIDGE PLANTATION OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, whose mailing address is 1914 Art Museum Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32207 ("Grantor") and THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose mailing address is 900 Walnut Street, Green Cove Springs, Florida 32043 ("Grantee") and whose taxpayer identification number is $\qquad$ .

## WITNESSETH

For and in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 Dollars (\$10.00) in hand paid by Grantee to Grantor and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Grantor hereby gives, grants, bargains, sells and conveys to Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, a perpetual and unobstructed easement for drainage purposes as now existing over, across, under and through that certain parcel of land located in Clay County, Florida, more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto ("Easement Land") including the right to install, construct, operate, repair and maintain the dry pond, swales and pipes as now existing on the Easement Land. Grantor, its successors and assigns, agrees to maintain the stormwater management facility located within the Easement Land in its present condition; provided, however, that upon conveyance of the Easement Land by Grantor, the grantee under such conveyance shall become responsible for such maintenance and Grantor shall be released and relieved of all obligations hereunder; and provided further that Grantee shall be responsible at all times for compliance with the St. Johns River Water Management District permit issued to Grantee for such stormwater management facility.

This easement shall be for the use and benefit of Grantee, its successors and assigns, and shall run with title to the Easement Land.

Together with the right of Grantee, its successors and assigns, to ingress and egress to, over and across the Easement Land and to do anything necessary or useful or convenient for the enjoyment of the easement herein granted.

The easement granted herein shall not be exclusive of use by Grantor, or its successors and assigns, so long as such use does not interfere with the rights granted herein.

To the extent permitted by law, by acceptance hereof, Grantee shall indemnify and hold Grantor harmless from and against all claims, demands, damages, actions, losses, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, relating to property damage or personal injury occurring upon the Easement Land, unless such damage or personal injury shall be the result of Grantor's negligence or willful misconduct.
