

Adult Education Proposed Policy Change Proposal: Tuition Items

The Adult and Community Education office is requesting permission to propose tuition for Adult Education students beginning July 1, 2011.

The programs/and codes that will be affected by the tuition implementation are as follows:

Adult Basic Education- 9900000

Adult High School – 9900099

GED Preparatory – 9900020

Adult ESOL – 9900040

Academic Skills for ESOL -9900051

The standard fee that has been signed into laws by the 2011 legislative session is as follows:

Tuition: \$30.00 per term (3 terms). Total tuition per year is \$90.00 in state residence

Out –of-State Fee (residency status criteria for an out of state student is identified in 1009.21): \$270.00 \$135 per half year or \$90 per term

Waivers may be permitted for up to **8%** of the fee revenues that would be otherwise collected. Florida Statutes 1009.26(1).

Per section 1009.22 (3) (e) Florida Statutes , each district school board may adapt tuition and out-of-state fees that vary no more than 5 percent above or below the combined total of the standard tuition of out of state fees. **The Adult Education office is requesting the standard tuition of \$90.00/year (\$ 30.00 per term) or the out of state tuition of \$270/year(\$90.00 per term) proposed by the recent legislation.**

Florida Statutes specifies that all funds received from the block tuition **must be used** only for adult general education programs. The institution must also have policies and procedures for the accounting of the expenditure of these funds.

Implementation of this law will go into effect **July 1, 2011.**
