Moving from Good to Great


- Clay County exceeded the state percentage of students scoring proficient (Level 3 and above) at all grade levels and in all content areas
- Out of the 67 districts, Clay scored in the top 15 in all areas with the exception of Mathematics at grades 4 and 8
- Clay 6th graders ranked 3rd in the state in Reading and 4th in Mathematics
- Clay ranked 7th in reading proficiency at grade 4
- Clay ranked 7th in math proficiency at grade 7




Moving from Good to Great

- Grade 8 science had the highest overall increase improving by 5 percent followed by a 4 percent improvement at grade 8 in reading
- In the 7 areas reported, Clay improved in 3, stayed the same in 2 and declined in 2 however, the decline was by 1 percent in 3-5 reading and 2 percent in grades 6-8 math
- Algebra 1 scores increased by 8 percent with a passing rate of 77 percent excluding retakes.
- Grade 8 writing increased by 4 percent and grade 10 increased by 12 percent.






Overall Elementary FCAT Reading Proficiency Percentages
