

Timeline Concerning ROTC at KHHS

- Late February: Mrs. Kornegay contacts me about ROTC possibilities at KHHS
- Early March: Begin making contact with Navy and Army ROTC
 - Meet at CHS with Dr. Sailor to discuss possibilities of a .6;
 - Realize that there are logistical issues with this plan and possibility of jeopardizing the standing of CHS program;
 - Learn of a NDCC program from the lead instructor at CHS
- Late March: begin investigating possibilities of NDCC at KHHS
 - Due to this possibility, I inform Dr. Sailor to include courses in selection sheets for students. Also based on the student survey from KHHS
- Mid April: begin phone conversations with Navy. Told that Navy was not adding any programs – NJROTC or NDCC
- Mid April: call Army about possibility of NDCC.
- Early May: Army very positive about the possibility of NDCC. Began a series of conversations with Army about:
 - Possible numbers at KHHS
 - Selection of Instructor
 - Overall Costs
 - Future status of program
- Mid May: Informed KHHS (Sailor), Van Zant, Adams, Kornegay of status of ROTC program at KHHS.
 - Connected Dr. Sailor with Army contact;
 - KHHS completed application
 - KHHS arranged for a facility review (Army representative)
 - Discussed with Adams about allocation issue (KHHS would reduce by 1 allocation in order to initiate the program requiring 1 ROTC instructor)
 - Completed allocation request for approval from Adams
 - KHHS now has sole communication/implementation responsibilities with Army
