FTC Clay Rookie Mentor Summer Bootcamp

Scope of Work:

FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) is a non-profit that offers 4 distinct levels of robotics competitions to children in grades k-12. This year marks the start of at least 5 new FTC (FIRST Tech Challenge) teams in Clay County secondary schools.

In order to ensure the success of the expansion of FIRST through Clay County, a **Rookie Mentor Bootcamp** class will be offered by Mark McCombs, a 12-year FIRST veteran and Mechanical Engineer. The class will provide training for design, construction, programming, and robot testing as well as FTC League organizing to incorporate Duval and Nassau County rookie FTC teams for League Play in Fall 14' – Spring 15.

Bootcamp will take place in the manufacturing house of Renaissance Robotics and Engineering located near the junction of I-10 and I-95 in the Riverside area.

July 22-26 (Tuesday - Friday 3pm-8pm, Saturday Noon-6pm)

Day 1 – Teachers will become familiar with the FTC Kit of Parts as well as how an FTC Season operates.

- Each team will set a schedule and test it during the rest of the camp. The condensed time of the camp will allow for 6 weeks of work to be completed in 4 days.
- Available online and local resources will also be covered.

Day 2 - Design, Build, Test, Communications, and Programming

- Mechanisms, Motors, and Wiring
- This day will be a fun build session where design logic and mechanical problem solving methods will be covered.

Day 3 - Team Formation, Fundraising, FIRST Ethos, Service Hours, Scholarships

- Action Plans for Fundraising, and how to get the kids involved at every step of the process of keeping your team going – Make them OWN IT!
- More Robot testing
- The FTC Arena will be in use by all groups on this day
