On 04-02-09 while assigned to the Juvenile Crime Section (OPHS), I investigated a grand theft complaint. Upon meeting with Mr. Anthony Williams (assistant principal), he said that a Dell lap top computer was stolen from Maria Orduna's class room. Mr. Williams said that this incident occurred on 03-25-09, but was not reported until 04-02-09.

Investigation revealed that on 03-25-09 Mrs. Orduna was on her planning break, and away from her portable. At this time she left her portable doors wide opened, and her lap top computer on her desk. During this time an unknown suspect(s) entered portable #7 and stole her lap top computer. Upon interviewing Mrs. Orduna, she was unable to provide any suspect information. She further said that she was on her planning break, and was talking with another teacher, when this incident occurred. She confirmed that she left both of her portable doors wide open. No other items were missing.

This case is pending.

On September 25, 2008 while performing my duties as a School Resource Officer at Ridgeview High, I met with the school's assistant principal in reference to the theft of a Dell Laptop computer.

I met with Mr. Feltner who said that an unknown person(s) stole a Dell Laptop computer from out of a class room. Mr. Feltner said that the computer was last seen on July 31, 2008 during the summer. He also said that different staff members were in and out of the building and the class room where the computer was last seen. Mr. Feltner said that the computer was last seen in building six and class room #629. He spoke with teachers whose class rooms are close to room #629 and he asked them about the computer. Mrs. Bonifacio, a teacher who has a class room near room #629 said she did not see the computer in the class room.

Mr. Feltner described the laptop as a Dell Laptop, model #Dell Latitude D800, serial #HH3S661, black in color and valued at \$1859.99. I later spoke with NCIC operator Akin #557 in reference to having the laptop entered into the system.
