NARRATIVE

On 03/26/07, at 06:55 hours, I was dispatched to Grove Park Elementary school in reference to a burglary. Upon arrival I made contact with R1, Diana Bellamy, the head custodian for the school. Diana advised that when she came in this morning one of the teachers, Barbara Doggett, advised R1 that her portable class room had been entered sometime over the Easter break. Further investigation revealed that a total of eighteen portable buildings had been entered, and that an estimated \$800.00 Worth of merchandise has been reported stolen so far. Several of the portables entered were also vandalized by the suspects discharging the fire extinguishers in the room. Entry was gained into all the buildings by the suspects using some type of pry instrument and sliding the door latch back opening the door. Numerous pry marks were observed in the wood door jam area of all the doors. A small two step folding metal stool, was discovered by the south fence in the area of the clinic. This appears to have been used by the suspects when leaving the campus. Due to the heavy morning dew no latent prints could be obtained. I spoke to Melissa Taiclet, a teacher at the school who advised she was on campus on Sunday 03/25/07, around 18:00 hours, and she exited by where the step stool was located, and advised it was not there when she left. Also the refrigerator in building #38 was unplugged, and the ice had not melted, and the contents were still cold inside. I spoke to Ms. Wyatt, the schools principal, and advised her if any more items were discovered missing to make a list and contact me. I was contacted and advised that extensive damage was done to the electronic equipment in the rooms that the fire extinguishers were discharged in, and that numerous teacher's desks and storage cabinets were pried open and damaged, along with various types of liquids being poured out over electronic equipment and files.
