### **Amendment 100**

This amendment (the "Amendment") is made and entered into by and between Lutheran Services Florida, Inc. ("LSF") and School District of Clay County - SEDNET ("Provider") to be effective October 1, 2014. Provider and LSF may be referred to herein individually as a "party" or collectively as "the parties."

**Whereas**, LSF wishes to amend the contract entered into between said parties on July 1, 2012, the purpose of this amendment is to amend contract language, replace Exhibit H, 'Funding Detail' and Exhibit L, 'Funding and Cost Center Rate by Program.'

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants, and the mutual promises contained hereinafter, and in exchange for good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties, as independent contractors, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Capitalized terms herein shall be ascribed the meaning given by the Contract. In the event of conflict between this Amendment and the Contract, this Amendment shall control.
- 2. Standard Contract, Paragraph 3, 'Payment for Services' is amended to: "contract of an amount not to exceed **\$543.049.00**, or the rate schedule, subject to the availability of funds" and is otherwise unchanged.
- 3. Attachment I, Paragraph A.1.b.(3) is replaced in its entirety with the following paragraph:
  - (3) Bed Count. The Network Service Provider's daily census, which reflects the number of beds occupied and the number of beds vacant.
- 4. Attachment I, Paragraph B.1.a.(10)(a)6. is replaced in its entirety with the following paragraph:
  - 6. The Network Service Provider is required to enter consumers on a wait list in accordance with PAM 155-2 and via the manner provided by the Managing Entity.
- 5. Attachment I, Paragraph B.1.a.(11) is replaced in its entirety, including all subparagraphs therein, with the following paragraph;
  - (11) Bed Count
  - (a) The Managing Entity must have the ability to provide, upon request, accurate and real time data on the number of available beds across the SOC.
  - (b) All Network Service Providers with licensed bed capacity shall respond to requests from the Managing Entity for information regarding bed count within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt of the request.
- 6. Attachment I, Paragraph C.1., 'Payment Clause' is amended to: "The contract total dollar amount shall not exceed **\$543.049.00**, subject to the availability of funds from the Department," and is otherwise unchanged.
- 7. Attachment I, Paragraph G is supplemented as follows:
  - **30.** Incorporated Document **30.** Children's Mental Health Care Coordination Program

- 8. Exhibit H, 'Funding Detail' is replaced in its entirety with the Exhibit H, 'Funding Detail' incorporated herein. All prior exhibits and attachments with reference to same content are deleted.
- 9. Exhibit L, 'Funding and Cost Center Rate by Program' is replaced in its entirety with a new Exhibit L, 'Funding and Cost Center Rate' incorporated herein. All prior exhibits and attachments with reference to same content are deleted.

Except as amended herein, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain the same in full effect and authority.

The parties' authorized representatives have executed this five-page Amendment to be effective this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2014.
