## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THAT PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS BUILDING 92 ROOMS 40, 41 and 42 AT GROVE PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, 1643 MILLER STREET, ORANGE PARK, FLORIDA ARE NO LONGER ELIGIBLE BY CODE ENFORCEMENT FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AND WOULD REQUIRE EXTENSIVE REPAIRS FOR ANCILLARY PURPOSES AND HAVE NO COMMERCIAL VALUE AND SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF BY THE MOST ECONOMIC MEANS.

WHEREAS, The School Board of Clay County, Florida wants to dispose of the structures described as relocatable Building 92, Rooms 40, 41 and 42 located at Grove Park Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the structures have deteriorated, are not cost effective to repair and are no longer utilized, serve no useful function and are without commercial value; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statue 1013.28 requires a determination that said structures are unusable for educational purposes and ancillary purposes and have no commercial value;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the School Board to dispose of said property by the most economical means of Clay County District Personnel;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the School District of Clay County, Florida, that the following described property is unusable for education and ancillary purposes and is without commercial value and in the best interest of the public should be disposed of by the most economic means. Said property is more particularly described as follows:

Structures: Building 92 Rooms 40, 41 and 42, are relocatable wooden buildings constructed in 1966, currently at Grove Park Elementary School, 1643 Miller Street, Orange Park, Florida.
