Differences in Current School Districts to Proposed School Districts

District 1 Janice Kerekes

- Expands South of Fleming Island along Peters Creek until it intersects with the railroad tracks then to CR 315 South to SR16.
- Expands to area South of SR 16 East of CR 315 (Spring Bank and Sharron Rd) to the Clay/Putnam County Line area includes the City Green Cove Springs.
- Loses the area West of the railroad tracks and CR 220 and areas North along College Dr. and Doctors Lake.

District 2 Carol Studdard

- Expands to area Northwest of Orange Park (West of SR 21); neighborhoods include: Cedar Bend, North Meadow Brook Terrace.
- Expands to area South of SR 21 and Kingsley Avenue to the Northeastern Shores of Doctors Lake to Holly Bay Rd. and South to Peoria Dr. neighborhoods include: all subdivisions along Moody Road.
- Maintains presence on Fleming Island East of SR 17.

District 3 Charlie Van Zant

- Expands to area East of SR 21 and South of Middleburg to South Fork Black Creek; then South to SR 16 West of Penny Farms; neighborhoods include: the Southeastern portion of unincorporated Middleburg.
- Expands to area Northeast along South Fork Black Creek and Old Jennings Rd. to SR 21.
- Gains area East of South Prong Black Creek to Thunder Road.

District 4 Frank Farrell

- Loses area West of Live Oak Lane, East of Yellow Water Creek.
- Loses area Northwest of Orange Park (West of SR 21); neighborhoods include: Cedar Bend, North Meadow Brook Terrace.
- Loses area South of Kingsley Avenue and SR 21 along Moody Road.

District 5 Lisa Graham

- Loses area West of South Fork Black Creek to SR 21.
- Loses area South of SR 16 and East of CR 315 (Spring Bank and Sharron Rd) to the Clay/Putnam County Line area includes the city of Green Cove Springs.
- Expands to area North of Black Creek and East to the railroad tracks and CR 220.
- Expands north of CR 220 to SR 21 and College Dr. to Peoria Rd. includes a portion of the Western Shores of Doctors Lake.
