The Schultz Center received \$1,570,000 from the Sate of Florida General Appropriations Act of 2002 – 2003 to connect Baker, Clay, Duval, St Johns and Nassau County school districts to the Schultz Center. The Schultz Center for Teaching and Leadership established a dedicated videoconferencing network system utilizing T1 lines. The funding for this project included videoconferencing equipment and software to support professional development training among these 5 school districts.
