On May 4, 2009 while performing my duties as a School Resource Officer at Ridgeview High, I met the school's head custodian Eugene Jenkins in reference to a number of portables being possibly broken into.

As Mr. Jenkins was escorting me to the portables, I saw the school's security cameras pushed in a upward position. I then checked the school's vending machines that are located in the school's court yard to see if they were damaged. After searching for any damages to the vending machines, I discovered that the machines were not damaged. Mr. Jenkins then escorted me to portable #68. When I entered the class room I noticed that an unknown person(s) entered the class room and discharged a fire extinguisher inside the class room. I then conducted a search around the portable for evidence. After conducting my search, I discovered a Nike shoe print around the portable. I also located two fire extinguishers under portable #66. I was also advised that nothing was taken out of the class room. The total value to clean the class room is \$150.00.

I then responded to the following portables that were reported to be entered.

\*Portable #66. No sign of force entry. File and desk drawers were opened. Nothing taken out of the class room. I discovered the Nike shoe print around the portable.

\*Portable #63. No sign of force entry. Desk drawers were opened. A Panasonic VCR was stolen from the class room. Serial # A3TB00248 and Model # AG-1350P. I discovered the Nike shoe print around the portable. Black in color and valued at \$30.00. RHS #665 and T-10259.

\*Portable #61. No sign of force entry. A Hitachi LCD projector was stolen from the class room. Serial # H7H003863 and Model # CP-X200. Silver in color and valued at \$900.00. Bar code 25400.

\*Portable #50. No sign of force entry. A Mitsubishi LCD projector was stolen from the class room. Serial #007016 and Model #SE2U. White in color and valued at \$900.00. Bar code #9633 and School Board #84262.

\*Portable 54. No sign of force entry. File cabinet and desk drawers opened. Closet door was opened, but nothing was taken from out of the class room. Nike shoe print located at the back of the portable.

\*Portable #47. No sign of force entry. I was advised that the front door was opened when the teacher arrived to school. File cabinet opened. DVD was stolen from out of the class room. Serial #609SHMF404019 and Model #DVB611. Silver in color and valued at \$50.00.

\*Portable #44. No sign of force entry. Desk drawers were opened and nothing taken from out of the class room. The Nike shoe print was located around the portable.

\*Portable #25. No sign of force entry. I cell phone was located in this class room on top of a chair. The teacher said that it did not belong to any of her students. Nothing stolen and nothing was disturbed.

\*Portable #45. No sign of force entry. Nothing disturbed. I was told that three canopies were missing from the class room. The canopies were located behind portable #54 and returned to the class room. No evidence located.
