## Modification #1 to the Amendment Two between Gaetz Aerospace Institute, The School Board of Clay County, Florida Academic Years 2024-2025

This First Modification (the "Modification") is entered into effective March 17, 2025, or on the last date approved by either party, whichever is later (the "Effective Date") and is by and between The School Board of Clay County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as the **DISTRICT**), and Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida (hereinafter referred to as **ERAU**)

Background. This Modification pertains to the Agreement between the parties dated effective on or about September 2, 2022 relating to the parties' agreement regarding dual enrollment/CTE courses for the 2022-2025 academic years (the "Agreement"). This Modification sets forth the budget for AY 24-25 in the amount of \$40,086.00 as shown in Attachment A AY 24-25 (Statement of Work and Budget) as a result of ERAU's provision of sections requested by the school district for the AY 24-25 school year. The number of sections for AY 24-25 are set forth in Attachment A, and the schedule of courses requested are set forth in the revised Appendix A AY24-25.

#### 2. Modification.

- (A) This modification is to set forth an additional amount of \$1,802.00 for the Agreement executed on July 2, 2024.
- (B) Section 4.0 of the Amendment is voided and replaced with the following:
