Superintendent Broskie provided an update on the 2023 to 2028 Clay County District Schools Strategic Plan, addressing progress made toward the five (5) goals as follows:

- **Student Success:** Highlighted the highest academic achievement in the history of Clay County last year and addressed the Florida School Grade Escalator, which will be implemented during the 2026 to 2027 school year.
- **Talent Recruitment, Development, and Retention:** Noted a 91% employee retention rate.
- **Family and Community Engagement:** Highlighted the Apptegy Communication System and the new Safety & Security Communications Specialist, who will provide clear and timely communications to families and the community.
- **Safe and Positive Learning Environment:** Highlighted the implementation of Centegix at all 42 schools and the District Office.
- **Fiscal and Operational Efficiency:** Highlighted the new Internal Accounts Handbook and implementation of the first level of multifactor authentication for all users.

Superintendent Broskie provided an overview of upcoming agenda items, including the public hearing on Board policies, acquisition of property for the Transportation Department, school improvement plans, enrollment and FTE updates, and routine contracts and operational items. He highlighted the District's continued growth, strong enrollment, facility improvements, and ongoing work to support student success.

Mrs. Gilhousen shared constituent concerns regarding after school programming. Superintendent Broskie provided an update on the Boys & Girls Club contract included on the upcoming consent agenda, noting that the organization will pursue additional funding to expand programming to schools not currently included.

Superintendent Broskie encouraged District leaders to celebrate the accomplishments of their staff and students while continuing to focus on the work necessary for continued success.
