- Ties together resiliency, character, civics, and health standards to improve student achievement
- Focuses on lifelong employability skills

Keeping 7 Mindsets

- Implementation with fidelity is the key to success

Twenty-nine schools expressed that they specifically want to keep 7 Mindsets.

- ❖ Already invested school funds for visuals, graphics, additional resources
- ❖ Imbedded into school culture and language after 5 years of implementation
- ❖ Valuable and easy to access content



Resiliency Toolkit is Not Enough

- Limited lesson coverage
 - Not enough lessons for each grade level
 - Does not cover all resiliency standards
 - Many lessons not designed for appropriate grade level
 - Not updated since 2023
 - Lessons were not written for Florida Resiliency standards- all are “borrowed” from other organizations
- Not formatted in a teacher and student friendly way
 - Random formats- no consistency
 - Links click to other sites/platforms from outside organizations

 - *Safety Standards with Bullying & Cyberbullying Prevention, Suicide Prevention, Child trafficking, Erin's Law, and new for 2024 – Grief and Loss modules*
- *Measures growth over time*
- *True targeted mental health supports*
- *Elementary modules taught small group with videos and educator resources*
- *Secondary modules can be student facing or educator led, or a hybrid of both*
- *Parent/Caregiver modules*
- *Educator guides*
- *Built in notification system*

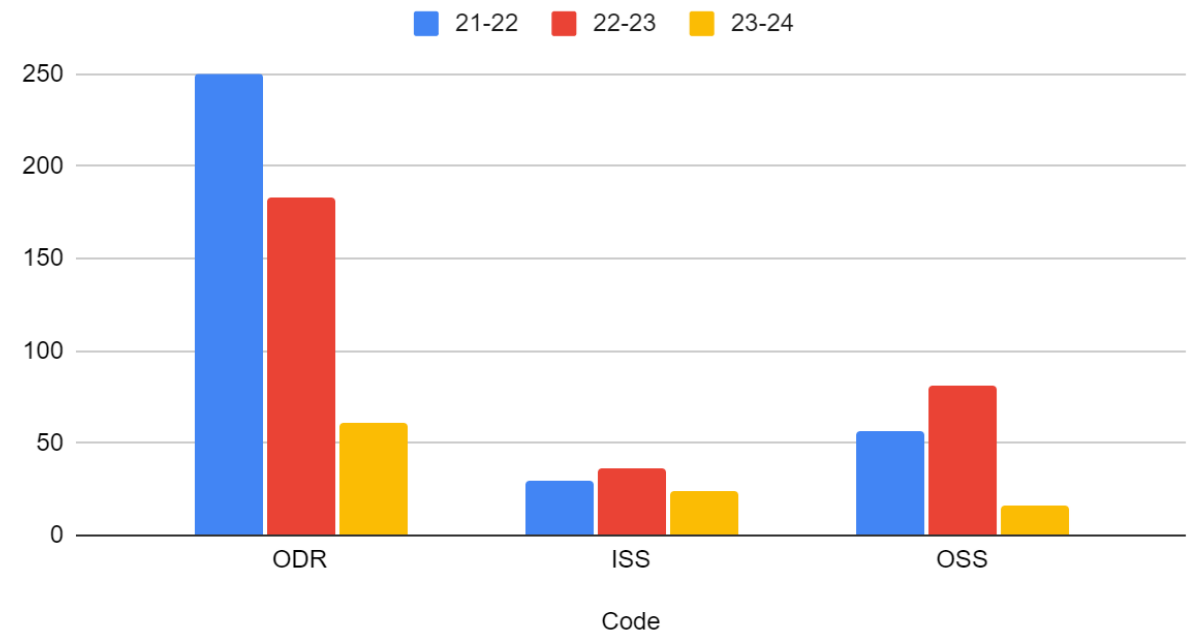
It's Working!

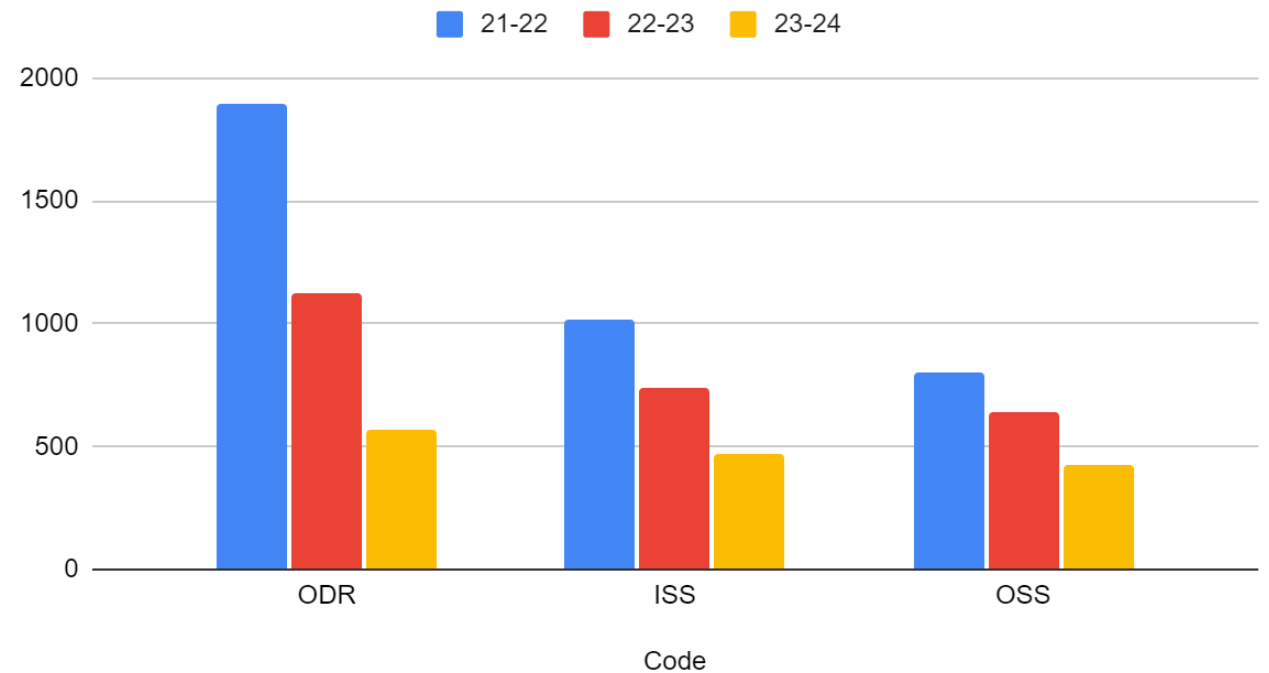
